### **Lower Your Taxes and Support Our Students**

The Arizona tax law (A.R.S. 43-1089.01) allows taxpayers a tax credit of up to \$400 (for married filing joint return) or \$200 (for an individual filer) if they contribute to extracurricular activities in public schools. A tax credit—which is the dollar-for-dollar reduction of your tax liability \_ is better than a tax deduction, which only reduces your taxable income before taxes are computed.

### You Need Not Be A Parent To Win!

The tax credit is available to all taxpayers, regardless of whether they have children in school. You don't have to live in our district to make a donation. Feel free to copy this form and give to other family members/friends who may want to help our students.

# What Is An Extracurricular Activity?

Extracurricular activity means any optional, noncredit educational or recreational activity that supplements the educational program. Activities such as athletics, visual/performing arts, special programs, clubs, outdoor education trips, gifted or classroom enrichment programs can be funded with tax credit money. To claim the credit, taxpayers must contribute to an activity for which the district requires a fee.

# It's This Easy!

If you want to support one or more of the programs listed on the response card, simply write a check to the Cartwright School District and indicate the school of your choice. Give the check and your completed response card to the secretary at the school you selected. You will receive a receipt verifying that you have contributed to an eligible extracurricular activity. Next spring, simply claim your tax credit up to \$400 (for married filing joint return) or \$200 (individual) on the appropriate tax form.

The amount of your donation does not have to be \$400 \_ you can make a difference to our students with any donation -\$50, \$75 or \$100.

### \*Know the Difference.

Contributions to public schools have always been tax deductible. The law allows a tax credit, which is subtracted from the amount of tax liability. For example, if your tax liability is \$400 in state income taxes and you donate \$200 to a public school for extracurricular activities, you may subtract the \$200 from your tax bill and pay the state just \$200.

# A Contribution Gets the Money Where It Needs To Go

Contributions that are eligible for a tax credit are donated directly to schools, not the state and not even to the school district. This funding will maintain/enhance extracurricular activities for students.

You may indicate which school and which program you would like to support -or, you may indicate which school you would like to support but allow them to choose the extracurricular activity by selecting general fund on the response card.

# Do It Today!

Schools are planning now for this year 's activities. Your contribution can make a big difference in a young person 's life. Simply complete the detachable response card and return or mail to the school of your choice, along with your check made payable to the *Cartwright School District* by *April 10, 2020*, or to the Cartwright School District Office, 5220 W. Indian School., Phoenix, AZ 85031 by *April 15, 2020*. You may also make a payment online using a debit or credit card by visiting www.csd83.org

You must designate a school to receive the donation, as no money can be donated to the district. The district also cannot determine which school is to receive the donation.
